

SCHOLARSHIPS

Huron University College rewards academic excellence and provides a number of automatic scholarships as well as scholarships that require an application. Huron guarantees a scholarship to any Canadian secondary school applicant with a final admission average of 85% or higher.

In addition, all National Scholarship winners are guaranteed their choice of building and room within residence and automatically become members of the "Huron Scholars Group." This group brings together high achieving students who hold renewable entrance scholarships, and senior scholarships at Huron. Members of the group are invited to a September reception and are kept informed of extra-curricular activities, award competitions, graduate application workshops, and other opportunities.

† The Huron National Scholarships are distinct from the National Scholarships offered by The University of Western Ontario. The Huron National Scholarships require a separate application form as noted in the chart and do not require the applicant to have been nominated by his/her school.

* Scholarship is renewable provided the student maintains a minimum average of 80% on 5.0 courses during the regular academic term to retain the award in subsequent years.

** The Principal's Scholarship may be "stacked" with other Huron awards.
